

















- Remove outer fairing and rest on a soft cloth.
- Clean any dust and debris from inside the outer fairing.
- Test fit Dynamat Xtreme to check for alignment and position with paper backing still attached.
- 4. Remove paper backing to expose butyl layer.
- Apply Dynamat Xtreme to designated area using light pressure at first, to aide in adjustment. (FIG 1, 2 AND 3)
- 6. Smooth from center outward to prevent air pockets. Use a rag or gloves and work into contours of the fairing. If an air pocket develops, simply puncture with a knife or pin and roll smooth.
- 7. Test fit Dynaliner to check alignment with paper backing still attached.
- Peel the release liner, and apply Dynaliner (COMPONENTS 12 & 13) directly to the outer fairing, pressing it firmly into place. (FIG 5 AND 6)




OUTER FAIRING
